#### **Children in Worship**

"Let the little children come to me; do not stop them; for it is to such as these that the kingdom of God belongs." - Mark 10:14b

This summer, our nursery will be open but unstaffed as we invite all ages to worship together in the sanctuary. Let us explore recapturing the "family in worship" and re-examine how we can better incorporate children in our worship.

A TIP FOR CONGREGATIONAL MEMBERS: Invite a child who is not your own to sit with you in worship on various Sundays (with parent's approval). This gives parents a chance to worship without any distraction and it gives you and the child an opportunity to develop a special bond.

A TIP FOR PARENTS/CAREGIVERS: If you feel your child's noise may bother others, try walking them around the back of the sanctuary until they quiet. If you remove them from the sanctuary, DO bring them back to the sanctuary – as that will help the child understand appropriate noise level and expectations of worship.

**FOR KIDS IN WORSHIP:** Today in worship, use a blank "frame" or other piece of paper to <u>draw a picture of communion in our sanctuary.</u> Write your name on it and leave it on the activity table at the back of the sanctuary. We will add it to our youth bulletin board in the lobby.


